

## Marshall H. Horowitz Prize for Research Excellence

The Marshall S. Horowitz Prize for Research Excellence honors research faculty at Albert Einstein College of Medicine who conduct groundbreaking research in the basic sciences. Named after Dr. Marshall Horowitz, an internationally renowned physician-scientist who discovered how genes encoded by adenovirus caused disease and then converted those disease-causing genes into therapeutic tools for diabetes, the award recognizes faculty who demonstrate exceptional research scholarship. Dr. Horowitz was one of the founding faculty of Einstein's M.D./Ph.D. program and served as the former chair of Montefiore Einstein's Department of Microbiology and Immunology.
