

+ Occupational Exposures



Einstein's Occupational Health Service (OHS) provides consultations to matriculated and visiting students who experience occupational exposures to blood or other bodily fluids during their training.

If you experience a needlestick, a splash, or another event involving contact with bodily fluids, it is important that you act immediately:



CLEAN the affected area:

- Wash the site of the needlestick or cut with soap and water.
- Flush splashes to the nose, mouth, or skin with water.
- Irrigate eyes with clean water or saline.



CONTACT:

- Notify your supervisor (resident, attending)



CARE:

- Go to the nearest ED for immediate evaluation and care
- Report the incident to Einstein OHS at: occupational-health@einsteinmed.edu and consult on next steps (please email your ED visit summary)



CONTINUE CARE:

- If follow-up care is required, OHS will refer you to Dr. LeFrancois at the SHC. Make an appointment via MyChart or call [347-498-2439](tel:347-498-2439)
- Any Rx should be filled at Montefiore Pharmacy
